**Adjustment of Status for Certain Citizens or Nationals of
Viet Nam, Cambodia and Laos**
(Section 586 of public law 106-429)

This is an official announcement from BCIS, the new Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services:

Are you from Cambodia, Laos or Viet Nam?

Were you paroled into the United States before October 1, 1997?

Were you paroled in under the Orderly Departure Program or from a refugee camp in Southeast Asia or displaced persons camp in Thailand?

If so, you may be eligible to apply for a green card. But there are only 5,000 slots so you must hurry. BCIS will send you a receipt notice when they receive your application. They will adjudicate each application in the order in which it was received, except in cases requiring a waiver of certain grounds of inadmissibility.

To apply, you must file an application with the BCIS.
